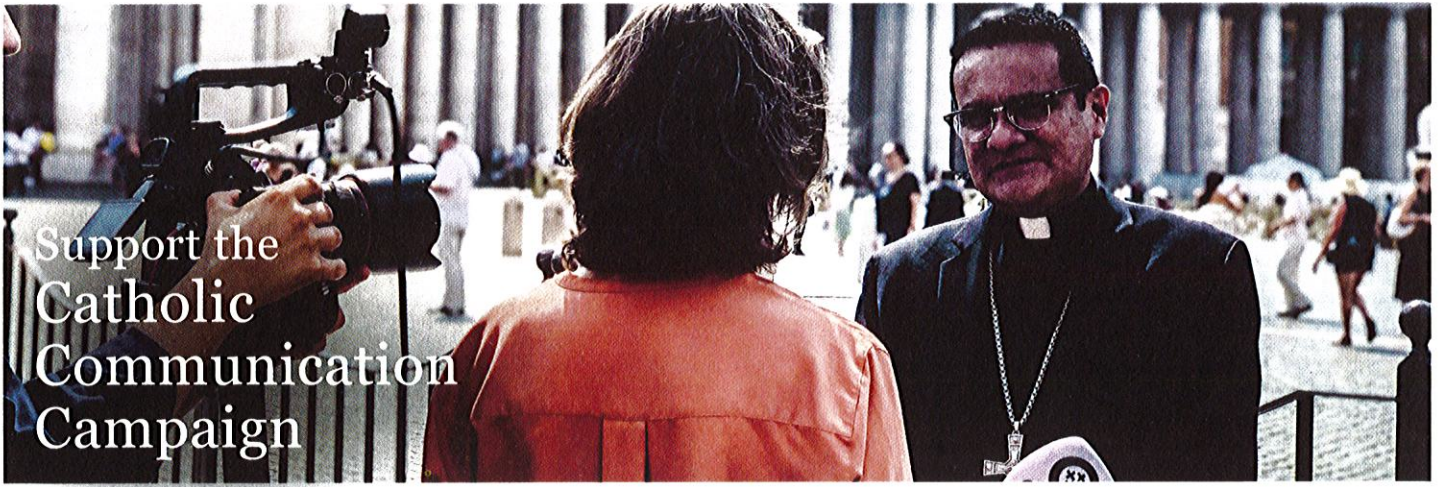
CALLING ALL VBS VOLUNTEERS

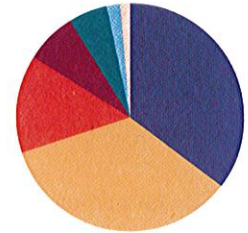

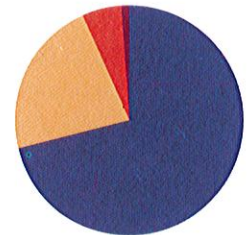
